

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Land acknowledgment statement

Sheridan's definition of pathways

Pathways are different routes that individuals take to progress through the education system. The pathways system assists qualified students to move between or within postsecondary institutions or programs recognizing previous, relevant learning.

Pathways relate to credit transfer and credit recognition involving prior learning, high school courses, preparatory programs, apprenticeships, certificates, diplomas, advanced diplomas, undergraduate and graduate degrees, and established articulation agreements.

Continuing your education

Access to Sheridan's various pathways allow you to build on your existing credentials and experience, making it easier to get credit for what you already know. In addition to a number of exciting pathways within our own programs, Sheridan has transfer agreements with universities and colleges around the world. If you decide to continue your studies at another college or university, you may be able to transfer some of your Sheridan credits.

A Sheridan diploma may also lead to admission into a degree program.

General transfer information

Each institution determines its own transfer policies, which are subject to change. This brochure is intended as a general guide to help you get started. For more information, contact the Admissions Office at the institution you're interested in attending. As well as the transfer opportunities listed in this brochure, you'll find that most institutions consider additional admission and credit transfer applications to programs based on their general transfer policies. The amount of credit transfer given will vary depending on the institution, the program and your marks. For more details, visit the websites of the institutions you're interested in and search for "transfer student" policies. Additional resources are available at ONTransfer.ca. Sheridan students and alumni may also consult with a Career Counsellor in Sheridan's Career Centre for further quidance.

Eligibility for a degree program

If you complete one year of study at Sheridan, you may be eligible for admission into Year 1 of a degree program at most institutions, even if you don't have the required degree entrance requirements from high school; however, some programs have additional prerequisites that you'll be responsible for successfully completing. You must meet the institution's minimum grade requirement to be considered, and in many cases may need to exceed that requirement for admission. Supporting documents such as portfolios, résumés and letters of reference may also be required.

Are you coming to Sheridan from another postsecondary institution?

Once you've been accepted to Sheridan and have paid your fees, you can access our online credit transfer services to see what previous learning credits may be applied to your current program of study.

Transferring credits

Institutions typically grant transfer credit based on the following:

- The compatibility of your diploma studies with the program you wish to enter.
- Your overall academic average at Sheridan and, in some cases, your individual course marks.

Some institutions grant "block transfer credit" based on the length of your Sheridan studies. Other institutions assess credit transfer on a course-by-course basis (advanced standing). It's important that you check with the Admissions Office at the institution you wish to attend.

- To a college or university outside Ontario: contact the institution directly.

Dual Credits

Applicants who do not possess the necessary admission requirements for Applied Health programs (Honours Bachelor of Applied Health Sciences - Athletic Therapy, Honours Bachelor of Health Sciences - Kinesiology and Health Promotion, Pharmacy Technician, Animal Care, Veterinary Technician and Practical Nursing) at Sheridan who complete the Pre-Health Sciences Pathway to Advanced Diplomas and Degrees will be granted admission, contingent on space in the program (in the semester they are applying for), if they have an overall GPA of 70% and a minimum grade of 70% in all of their science and math courses.

Course completion requirements vary and are dependent on program. Applicants from the Pre-Health Sciences Pathway to Advanced Diplomas and Degrees program must complete all other pre-admission requirements for their chosen program. As of January 2021, Pre-Health students are no longer required to complete the Health Occupational Aptitude Exam for entry into Veterinarian Technician and Practical Nursing programs.




