New lockdown measures - no change to classes

April 1, 2021

Dear Sheridan Community,

Earlier today, Ontario Premier Doug Ford, Health Minister Christine Elliott and Ontario's Chief Medical Officer of Health Dr. Williams announced additional COVID-19 restrictions.

As of 12:01 a.m. on Saturday, April 3, 2021, the entire province of Ontario will move into the new "shutdown" level for a period of 28 days. These measures are being put into effect to limit the possibility of community transmission in order to mediate the impacts of new variants of concern and safeguard the capacity of the health care system.

We have not learned of any required changes to our operations. Subsequently, there will be no impact to any of Sheridan's currently scheduled teaching and learning activities. All classes that are currently being taught remotely will continue to be taught remotely. All existing in-person instruction will continue as planned. Sheridan's childcare centres and student health centres will remain open. Should we learn of any changes to our operations, we will inform the Sheridan community as soon as possible.
