### **Partnership Engage Grants**

## Subject Area:

Social sciences and humanities.

Applicants are advised to review <u>Imagining Canada's Future</u>'s 16 future global challenges and to consider addressing one or more of these areas in their research proposal.

### Intended to:

- Support <u>short-term</u> and timely support for partnered research activities that will inform decision-making at a <u>single partner organization</u> from the public, private or not-for-profit sector
- Respond to immediate needs and time constraints facing organizations in <u>non-academic</u> sectors
- Applications involving Indigenous research, as well as those involving research-creation are welcomed

#### Conditions:

- Applications may be submitted by an individual researcher or a team of researchers (one applicant and one or more co-applicants and/or collaborators).
- Co-applicants may be affiliated with an eligible Canadian postsecondary institution, notfor-profit organization, philanthropic foundation, think tank, or municipal, territorial or provincial government OR an international postsecondary institution.
- Only <u>ONE</u> Canadian or international organization from the public, private or not-for-profit sector may be involved as a partner organization. Postsecondary institutions, as well as any organization or association affiliated with or servicing them, are <u>NOT</u> eligible as partner organizations.
- Co-applicants from eligible not-for-profit organizations may request a salary research allowance to release them from duties to their organization.
- SSHRC and its partner organizations offer initiatives that complement this funding opportunity:
  - Applicants working with Canadian businesses and/or eligible not-for-profit organizations may be eligible for student internship co-funding, through the <u>Mitacs Accelerate</u> program

Value: \$7,000 to \$25,000 over one year

Partner's Contribution: Cash and/or in-kind contributions are expected

Sheridan's Contribution: Not required

**Application Deadline:** September 15, December 15, March 15 and June 15 **Notification of Award Decision:** Two months after the application deadline

Applications will be made by the Sheridan Research Office on behalf of the Principal Investigator(s).
