FedDev Ontario

Southern Ontario Network for Advanced Manufacturing Innovation (SONAMI)

Subject Area:

 Advanced manufacturing, including additive manufacturing, robotics and automation, simulation and design, sensors and IOT.

Intended to:

 Support applied research collaborations with Small and Medium Sized companies in the manufacturing sector, to help solve their challenges, adapt new technologies, develop new prototypes, and bring new products to the market.

Conditions:

- Industry partners must be manufacturing companies located in Southern Ontario, and have 500 or fewer employees.
- Projects are conducted at CAMDT and may include full- or part-time faculty, technologists, staff and students.

Value: \$5,000 to \$100,000 (total budget), up to 1 year

Company Contribution: Matching funds at a minimum ratio of 1:1.2 (20% cash and 80% in-kind). For example, if FedDev funding is \$20,000, the partner must provide \$24,000 (of which \$4,800 is cash, and \$19,200 is in-kind), for a total budget of \$44,000.

Sheridan's Contribution: Not required Application Deadlines: No deadline

Notification of Award Decision: 4-6 weeks

How to Apply: The industry partner should submit the <u>CAMDT partnership intake form</u>. Once the Principal Investigator (PI), partner, and project have been confirmed, the PI will submit a project proposal for internal review.
