Natural Sciences and Engineering Research Council of Canada (NSERC)

Applied Research Tools and Instruments (ARTI) Grants

Subject Area:

Across the spectrum of natural and social sciences, engineering, humanities or health.

Intended to:

- Support the <u>purchase of research equipment</u> and installations to foster and enhance the capacity of colleges to undertake applied research, innovation and training in collaboration with local companies, particularly <u>small and medium-sized enterprises</u> (<u>SMEs</u>).
- Equipment may be a single item or a collection of items forming a comprehensive system.

Conditions:

- NSERC will accept applications for research equipment whose total net cost is up to \$250,000, provided that the applicant is able to secure funding from other sources to bring the amount requested to \$150,000 or less.
- The use of other College and Community Innovation grants is permitted with prior written approval from NSERC.
- Salaries and benefits, insurance costs and overhead and administration costs are not eligible.
- A minimum of one letter of support from a private-sector company or business association outlining their interest in the requested applied research equipment is required.

Value: Between \$7,000 and \$150,000 for one year

Company Contribution: Not required

Sheridan's Contribution: Not required

Application Deadline: Typically annually in November (currently closed)

Notification of Award Decision: 16 weeks
