# Natural Sciences and Engineering Research Council of Canada (NSERC)

Innovation Enhancement (IE) Grants (Build IE & Extend IE)

## **Subject Area:**

Across the spectrum of natural and social sciences, engineering, humanities or health.

#### Intended to:

- Increase innovation at the community and/or regional level by enabling <u>Canadian</u> <u>colleges to increase their capacity</u> to work with local companies, particularly small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs).
- The grant focuses on <u>ONE area</u> where the college has recognized expertise and that meets local or regional economic development needs.
- Highly competitive grant application with potential of renewal.
- For the Build IE Grants competition, NSERC and the Canada Foundation for Innovation (CFI) have developed a joint application and review procedure for a comprehensive funding package supporting both research costs and research infrastructure.

#### **Conditions:**

- Sheridan is only eligible for Build and Extend IE Grants (not Entry Level IE Grants).
- Build IE Grant applications should focus on <u>different</u> applied research <u>disciplines</u>, technical expertise and facilities, and support a <u>different</u> and significant <u>industry sector</u>, versus previously awarded Build IE grants at the college.
- Colleges with a previously awarded Build IE Grant are eligible to apply for Extend IE Grant in the <u>same</u> sector.

**Value:** Build IE: \$400,000 per year for five years

Extend IE: \$300,000 per year for three years

Company Contribution\*: Build IE: Cash and/or in-kind contributions totalling a minimum of

\$300,000, of which at least \$75,000 must be in cash over the five years of

the grant.

Extend IE: Cash and/or in-kind contributions totalling a minimum of \$600,000, of which at least \$300,000 must be in cash over the three

years of the grant.

\*The above contributions are required to be committed <u>at the time of application</u>. Additional, progressively increasing contributions are required through the term of the grant.

Sheridan's Contribution: Not required
